

Bank Michigan Scholarship Information

Bank Michigan is offering a scholarship to graduating high school students in our branch locations of Onsted, Brooklyn, and Manchester entering a college, university or trade school with a GPA of 2.0 or higher. Each application shall be accompanied by an essay with the following parameters:

- 2 ½ to 3 pages or 1200 to 1500 words, single-spaced.
- Font size: 14
- Font type: Arial
- Topic: Explain how your volunteerism has impacted your career choice.
- Essays should not include applicant name or descriptions that may identify them.

Each essay packet submitted will include the essay as well as the completed application.

1. Applicant screening will use a blind judging system ensuring the judges will not know the applicant's information. Judges will be looking for correct formatting, spelling and grammar, length of essay, and the applicant's explanation of the topic. Scoring of applications will include deductions if the essay contains the applicant's name or description that could identify the applicant.
2. Immediate family members of Bank Michigan employees are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.
3. Essays will be accepted December 1, 2025 through January 31, 2026 and can be mailed to: Bank Michigan P.O. Box 738 Brooklyn MI 49230 or emailed to scholarships@bankmichigan.bank.
4. Winners will be determined by April 15, 2026, and awards presented at the school's Award's Night.
